TITLE: Developmental Therapist

SUPERVISOR: Children's Services Program Coordinator

RESPONSIBILITY: Facilitate Early Intervention services to infants and toddlers birth to three years old (and their families) that meet Early Intervention criteria. Provide direct services in a natural environment; with an occasional exception for center-base programming when required by the CFC. Informal instruction to parents and other family members as determined by the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP).

QUALIFICATIONS:

- B.S. degree or higher in Early Childhood, Special Education/Early Childhood, Child Development, Early Intervention, or Elementary Education is required. *The college/university attended must be approved through Early Intervention.*
- Applicant must also document the completion of educational experiences as approved by the Department that include at least 2 semester college hours of, or the equivalent (30 clock hours or CEU credit hours) in, each of the following EI core knowledge content areas:(1) The Development of Young Children (1 semester hour Typical Development and 1 semester hour Atypical Development),(2) working with families of young children with disabilities, (3) intervention strategies for young children with special needs, and assessment of young children with special needs is required.
- The applicant must submit proof of training on the use of a formal assessment tool that would allow the provider to perform global evaluations and assessments required.
- Reliable transportation and insurance along with a clear Motor Vehicle Report required.
- Willing to undergo background checks required.
